MOTION TO INTERVENE OF HENDERSON MUNICIPAL POWER & LIGHT

The City of Henderson Utility Commission, d/b/a Henderson Municipal Power & Light (HMPL), by counsel, moves for full intervention in this matter pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8).

HMPL owns the Station Two Power Plant located near the Henderson/Webster County line, which pursuant to contractual arrangements was operated by Big Rivers Electric Corporation. In 1998, Louisville Gas & Electric Company became the operator of that Plant pursuant to certain bankruptcy proceedings involving Big Rivers.

The pending Transaction Termination Agreement among Big Rivers and the E.ON parties involves the HMPL power plant and will have a direct impact on the continued operation of the power plant and the ability of HMPL to provide service to its customers.

Because the termination of the lease with Louisville Gas & Electric is proposed for 2008, rather than the initial termination date of 2023, HMPL must consent to the early termination.

This intervention is made for the purpose of assisting the Commission with the development of facts relevant to a decision and will not unduly delay or impede the proceedings. This case may have a direct and material effect upon HMPL's legal rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other legal interests. HMPL has a substantial and special interest in a Commission determination with respect to the issues raised that are not and cannot be otherwise adequately represented by any other party. The Commission's grant of full intervenor status to HMPL is likely to present issues or develop facts that facilitate the Commission's full consideration in this matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.

HMPL requests that it be granted full intervention with the right to participate in this proceeding as a party and that counsel for HMPL be served with all filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence and all other documents submitted by parties and be certified as a party for the purposes of receiving service of any petition for rehearing or judicial review.
