Come Kenergy Corp., Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation, and Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative, by and through counsel, and for their collective response to the Attorney General's Initial Request for Information to Member Cooperatives, state as follows:

1. State the facts and purposes which lead the member electric cooperatives to support the proposed Unwind Transaction and Lease Agreement termination which is the subject of this application.

RESPONSE. Please refer to the direct testimony of Burns Mercer, Exhibit 26. To summarize, the Members support the Unwind because:

- a. It will result in a more financially secure Big Rivers with positive equity and an investment grade credit rating. As owners of BREC it is in the Members' interest for BREC to have financial stability;
- b. BREC will be better able to provide power for economic development should the need arise; and

c. The Unwind will help to keep jobs in the local community by providing

the smelters a source of electricity that can maintain their profitability.
