# PETITION TO INTERVENE OF KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC.

Pursuant to K.R.S. §278.310 and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") requests that it be granted full intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding and states in support thereof as follows:

- 1. KIUC is an association of the largest electric and gas public utility customers in Kentucky. The purpose of KIUC is to represent the industrial viewpoint on energy and utility issues before this Commission and before all other appropriate governmental bodies. The members of KIUC who purchase electricity from Big Rivers Electric Corporation through Kenergy who will participate herein are: Alcan Primary Products Corporation, Century Aluminum of Kentucky, LLC, Commonwealth Aluminum Corporation, Domtar Paper Co., LLC and Kimberly Clark Corporation.
