Based on the unavailability of the AG's office, and the issues that creates if Commission counsel is involved in a call in their absence, we will reschedule the conference call we had proposed for this morning for 10:00 a.m. EDT tomorrow, Thursday, June 26, 2008. The call in number is 888-476-6131, participant code 934845.

A principal purpose of the call for today was to inform the parties and Commission counsel that the Ambac downgrade, and its implications under the Big Rivers' leveraged leases has created a problem that must be solved before a closing of the unwind transaction. And because that resolution will likely impact several aspects of the filings made in Case No. 2007-00455, E.ON and Big Rivers believe the hearing scheduled to begin next Tuesday should be postponed. At this point Big Rivers does not know what the solution to the problem will be, and does not know how long any solution achieved will take to implement.

We will ask to discuss tomorrow procedural issues in Case No. 2007-00455, and any questions that anyone has regarding the letter Big Rivers e-mailed last night regarding early termination of the Bank of America lease. We point out that the three distribution cooperative cases are also set for hearing next Tuesday.
