<u>O R D E R</u>

On October 17, 2007, Hardin County Water District No. 1 ("Hardin District") submitted a proposed tariff to allow a master meter to be utilized in manufactured housing communities while simultaneously using sub-meters to bill individuals. The intent is to account for any potential leak located within the communities and reduce Hardin District's unaccounted-for water loss. The proposed tariff states an effective date of December 15, 2007.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This proceeding is established to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed tariff.

2. The proposed tariff is suspended for 5 months from December 15, 2007 up to and including May 14, 2008.
