<u>ORDER</u>

Letcher County Water and Sewer District ("Letcher District") has applied to the Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct a waterworks improvement project and for authority to incur additional indebtedness to finance the proposed construction. In its filing, Letcher District requested permission to deviate from certain filing requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, which requires the submission of a detailed financial exhibit for the period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date of the application.

In support of its request for permission to deviate from Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, Letcher District states that its most recent financial exhibits are for the 12 months ended December 31, 2006 and that those exhibits are contained in its 2006 Annual Report on file with the Commission. Letcher District further states that this is the most recent financial data available and that no extraordinary circumstances have occurred since December 31, 2006 that would distort the year-end statement.

Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, provides the Commission with the authority to permit deviations from its regulations for good cause shown. Having reviewed the filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the requested deviations are reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Letcher District's request for permission to deviate from the filing requirements of Administrative Regulation 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 6, is granted.
