2. Describe the duties and responsibilities of Mr. Branham in regard to the day-to-day operations of Auxier Road. Who will succeed Mr. Branham in the performance of these duties?

Witness: Sallye Branham

Response: Mr. Branham oversaw all of the day to day operations of the company, including the non-regulated business matters such as corporate organization and tax compliance. He also was responsible for all regulated utility matters such as PSC safety and other regulatory compliance, financial and rate matters, gas supply and purchases, billing, customer relations, routine maintenance and operations. He was assisted in the performance of these duties by Sallye Branham, former vice president of the company, Kim Crisp and Susan Crum.

The duties have now been allocated among those three members of management. Sallye Branham has assumed the duties primarily associated with the chief corporate officer of corporate oversight. She also deals with PSC regulatory compliance, safety matters and supervision of the day to day office functions. Kim Crisp handles financial, accounting and regulatory reports, GCR filings, customer relations, billing and other duties as necessary. Susan Crum handles gas supply monitoring, billing, customer relations, computer needs and other duties as needed. The field work, maintenance, safety inspections, meter installations and meter reading are handled by the same employees, Alvis Scott and Timothy R. Daso, Jr., that have worked for Auxier for 18 and 11 years respectively.

Because the employees handling the day to day operations have worked for the Company for many years, there is continuity in the management of the Company and a familiarity on their part of the workings of the Company.

3 As President of Auxier Road, describe Sallye Branham's duties and responsibilities in the day-today operations and management of Auxier Road.

Response: Sallye Branham has worked for Auxier Road Gas Company since the inception of the company in 1963. She has also worked for Sigma Gas Company and assisted with the operations of Johnson County Gas Company, and Martin Gas Company. She has extensive experience with the day to day operations of small gas utilities, including PSC regulations, customer relations, billing, gas supply and purchases, safety, corporate compliance and accounting matters.

Kim Crisp has worked for Auxier since 1984. She has also worked for Sigma Gas Company, Johnson County Gas and Martin Gas Company. She has a degree in accounting and has been responsible for the financial compliance and reporting matters of the Company. She also performs the duties described in Response 2.

Susan Crum has also worked for Auxier since 1984. As well as working for Sigma Gas Company for 10 years, Johnson County and Martin Gas Companies. She has an accounting degree and her duties are listed in Response 2.

Field Employee Alvis Scott has been an employee with Estill Branham for 18 years. Timothy R. Daso, Jr. has been with the Company for 11 years. They were also employees of Sigma Gas Corporation which was operated by Mr. Branham.

Response: The Prestonsburg city utility, Prestonsburg, Kentucky, has offered to provide any assistance needed to supplement the field work of Auxier, including labor, equipment and materials. The proximity of the city system to Auxier makes this arrangement beneficial for routine relocations, installations and other non-emergency work. It also provides Auxier with back-up assistance if an emergency should arise that requires additional labor or equipment to supplement Auxier's staff.
