BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: That Section § 51.42 of the Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:

(A) Section § 51.42 <u>Water Rates</u>. All water customers of the City of Carlisle beginning with the bills due July, 2000 shall pay the following rates for water:

The rate for all water hauled from the water plant is \$6.25 5-59 per 1,000 gallons.

- (B) All water customers shall pay a minimum charge per month in an amount equal to the rate for the first 1,000 gallons or less as set out above, and the City Clerk/Treasurer shall so bill the customers.
- (C) Industrial Rate: Any Industrial water customer using in excess of an average of five million gallons (5MG) of water per month each month for the previous twelve (12) month period shall qualify for the Industrial rate. There will also be a payment of a monthly service charge of \$250.00 Industrial Rate Customers.
