PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
ALCAN PRIMARY PRODUCTS CORPORATION AND
CENTURY ALUMINUM OF KENTUCKY GENERAL PARTNERSHIP

Pursuant to K.R.S. §278.310 and 807 KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), Alcan Primary Products Corporation and Century Aluminum of Kentucky General Partnership (“Alcan/Century”) request that they be granted full intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding and state in support thereof as follows:

1. Alcan/Century are by far the biggest power consumers in Kentucky. They have a combined demand of approximately 850 MW and consume more than seven billion kWh annually. Alcan/Century are retail ratepayers of Kenergy Corporation (“Kenergy”). Kenergy is part owner of Big Rivers Electric (“Big Rivers”) and purchases generation and transmission service from Big Rivers.
2. The matters being decided by the Commission in this case may have a significant impact on the cost of electric power to Alcan/Century. Electricity represents a significant cost of doing business for Alcan/Century and is critical to the continued economic viability of their operations.
