Pursuant to the request of the Breathitt County Water District ("Breathitt District"), a teleconference was held on May 13, 2008. Participating were the following:

Breathitt District discussed its proposed contract with Kentucky Mountain Bible College ("Bible College") and the average water usage expected by Bible College under the contract. Breathitt District stated that Bible College consists of 40 structures and houses approximately 100 students. Its current water usage is approximately 228,000 gallons per month. The contract would be for general water service to Bible College and any of its fire protection needs. There was general discussion about the history of Bible College, including its initial financing, its current customer base, and its rate structure.

Commission Staff stated that Bible College could request Commission assistance in preparing a cost-of-service study and rate analysis.

Bible College agreed to file a revised contract, consistent with the information discussed. Bible College will also file copies of minutes of each meeting in which the proposed contract was discussed and all correspondence between Breathitt District and Bible College regarding the proposed contract for water service.
