The Commission staff has reviewed your application in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

1. Filing deficiencies pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001:

807 KAR 5:001: Section 8(3) If applicant is a corporation, a certified copy of its Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto, if any, shall be annexed to the application. If applicant's Articles of Incorporation and amendments thereto, if any, have already been filed with the Commission in some prior proceeding, it will be sufficient if this fact is stated in the application and reference is made to the style and case number of the prior proceeding.

The statutory time period in which the Commission must process this case will not commence until the above-mentioned information is filed with the Commission. If your filing contains a proposed effective date, the rejection of your filing for reasons of deficiencies voids that proposed effective date. When you file the required information to correct the deficiencies, you may refile your proposed tariff with a new proposed effective date that is at least 30 days from the date you file the required information. You are requested to file 1 copies of this information within 15 days of date of this letter. If you need further assistance, please contact Eric Bowman at 502/564-3940 ext. 440.

IN THE MATTER OF THE TODD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

ORDER ESTABLISHING AND CREATING WATER DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS TODD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been filed a Petition by at least 25 freeholders and residents of an area lying in this County, for the creation of a water district, and asking that same be named the TODD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT pursuant to Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Court, by Order entered on November //, 1971, set the case for Hearing on the 28th day of December, 1971, at 1:00 P.M., C.S.T., and

WHEREAS, a Notice of the filing of such Petition and Notice of the Hearing as to same, was duly published in the TODD COUNTY STANDARD on November 18, 1971, and on December 9, 1971, advising interested parties of the fact that they were afforded a period of thirty days after the first publication of said Notice within which to file objections to the creation of said District, in compliance with all legal requirements, as set out in Affidavit of Publication heretofore filed in this proceeding, and

WHEREAS, a period of thirty days has expired after the first publication of such Notice, during which time all residents of the proposed district had an opportunity to file objections, and

WHEREAS, the Court has found and does hereby find that the establishment of said district is reasonably necessary for the public health, convenience, fire protection, safety and comfort of the residents within the area described in the Petition as being the area sought to be established as said water district, and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That this Court has found and does hereby find that the establishment of a water district embracing the area described below is reasonably necessary for the public health, convenience, fire protection, safety and comfort of the residents of said area.
- 2. That this Court has determined and does hereby determine, that the original Petition filed in this Court for the creation of said Water District was signed by at least twenty-five (25) resident freeholders of the proposed District, as required by law, and that the creation of said District has been approved by the Public Service Commission of Kentucky as required by law, as evidenced by the Order of said Public Service Commission filed with said Petition.
- 3. That this Court has determined that the territory of said District, as described hereafter, embraces the incorporated sixth class City of Allensville in the County, and does not embrace any other municipality or any portion of an incorporated municipality or other District in the County, and that all of the territory embraced by the District is located within the boundaries of the County. This Court has further determined that the City of Allensville has consented to being included within the boundaries of the District by the enactment of an Ordinance of its Board of Trustees on Mourander 1/2, 1971, which Ordinance has been duly published in accordance with KRS Chapter 424, and that accordingly, the provisions of KRS 74.120 have been duly complied with.
- 4. That it is hereby ordered that there be and there is hereby established pursuant to KRS Chapter 74, a water district which shall have all of the powers available to water districts under KRS Chapter 74 and is hereby named "Todd County Water District."
- 5. It is further ordered that the boundaries of said District shall be and are hereby determined to be as follows:

Todd County, including the corporate limits of Allensville, and excluding the cities of Elkton, Trenton and Guthrie, Kentucky, and the areas served by their water systems.

6. It is further ordered that three Commissioners of said Water District shall be immediately appointed by separate Order of this Court, in accordance with Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
