RESPONSE OF SHELBY ENERGY COOPERATIVE, INC. TO COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND DATA REQUEST

Comes Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. (hereinafter "Shelby Energy"), and for its Response to Commission Staff's Second Data Request states as follows:

1. What is the value (as of the date Shelby Energy files its response to this data request) of the remaining services which Dobson Power Line Construction Company has yet to perform under the November 21, 2006 contract? If the exact value is unknown, provide an estimation of the amount, as well as a description of any variables that were used and how the value of those variables was approximate.

ANSWER: See attached Shelby Energy Cooperative 2008 Construction/Conversion List. The gross value of remaining projects under the Dobson contract is approximately \$595,492.00. Shelby Energy would normally purchase the materials for each

project regardless of the contractor, so the value of the estimated potential contract labor on the remaining Dobson projects is \$325,555.48.
