Pursuant to the Commission Staff notice issued on October 2, 2008, an informal conference was held on October 6, 2008 at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. The stated purpose of the conference was to discuss revisions to the procedural schedule. A list of the attendees is attached hereto.

Staff informed the attendees that the Commission Chairman had recently received an Opinion from the Executive Branch Ethics Commission advising him that, since his former law firm had performed work for LG&E's parent corporation, E.ON U.S., he should abstain from participating in any LG&E (or Kentucky Utilities Company) proceedings for six months from the date of his June 1, 2008 appointment to the Commission. Consequently, he has been abstaining from participating in this case and will continue to do so until December 1, 2008.

The revised procedural schedule was distributed to the participants, and a copy is attached hereto. Staff indicated that any objections to the revised procedural dates should be set forth in a written motion and submitted to the Commission. Staff also indicated that the Commission intended to hold four public hearings in different areas of the state to allow members of the public to comment on the pending LG&E (and KU) rate cases, and that those public meetings would be held during the first full week of January 2009.

The stated purpose of the KU conference was to discuss revisions to the procedural schedule and the participation of the Commissioners. A list of the attendees is attached hereto.

Staff informed the attendees that the Commission Chairman had recently received an Opinion from the Executive Branch Ethics Commission advising him that, since his former law firm had performed work for KU's parent corporation, E.ON U.S., he should abstain from participating in any KU (or Louisville Gas and Electric Company) proceedings for six months from the date of his June 1, 2008 appointment to the Commission. Consequently, he has been abstaining from participating in this case and will continue to do so until December 1, 2008.

Staff also indicated that the Vice Chairman had entered a formal Notice in the record of this case which discusses the Executive Branch Ethics Commission's Opinion issued to him and his need to abstain from participating in the KU proceeding as a result of LFUCG's intervention in the KU case. As a result of the need for both the Chairman and Vice Chairman to abstain until December 1 and December 16, 2008, respectively, the procedural schedule has been revised to reflect a delay in the evidentiary hearing until January 13, 2009.

The revised procedural schedule was distributed to the participants, and a copy is attached hereto. Staff indicated that any objections to the revised procedural dates should be set forth in a written motion and submitted to the Commission.
