## ORDER

On May 19, 2009, Commission Staff issued its second information request to Bullock Pen Water District ("Bullock Pen"). Items 3, 13, and 14 of this request sought information related to pro forma adjustments, fringe benefits, and health insurance available to Bullock Pen employees.

Bullock Pen responded to the information request on June 4, 2009. In its response, Bullock Pen attached documents that revealed its employees' social security numbers and insurance subscriber identification numbers.

All material filed with the Commission is subject to public disclosure unless that material is classified as confidential.<sup>1</sup> The Commission follows the guidelines of

KRS 61.870 *et seq.* in determining what information should be classified as confidential.<sup>2</sup> KRS 61.878(1)(a) provides that confidentiality should be provided to "[p]ublic records containing information of a personal nature where the public disclosure thereof would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy." The Attorney General has regularly held that social security numbers and other identification numbers fall within this provision.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, the Commission finds that the social security numbers and insurance subscriber identification numbers filed by Bullock Pen should be afforded confidential treatment.

The Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that the documents that revealed social security numbers and insurance subscriber identification numbers and that are attached to Bullock Pen's data response filed on June 4, 2009 shall be placed in a confidential file and that a redacted copy, which is attached as an appendix to this Order, be placed in the main public case file.
