SECOND REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO RESPOND

Comes now Bullock Pen Water District ("District"), through Counsel Thomas R. Nienaber, and respectfully requests of the Commission an extension of time to respond to its July 17, 2008 Request for Additional Information. The District would respectfully request that a second extension to provide the information requested be granted up to and including August 22, 2008.

GROUNDS

When the Commission submitted its first Request for Additional Information dated July 17, 2008, counsel was on vacation and did not receive that Request until his return on July 29, 2008. At that time, counsel contacted Ms. Renee Smith and requested an extension which was granted up to August 15, 2008. Subsequent to July 30, 2008, counsel began the process of obtaining the additional information identified in the Commission's correspondence dated July 17, 2008. In fact, the majority of the information requested has been accumulated. Unfortunately, the District's accountant, Morris & Bressler, PSC, Ms. Peggy Gamble, was hospitalized on August 6, 2008 and was not released until August 13, 2008. Ms. Gamble is the account representative with Morris & Bressler, P.S.C. that handles the financial data and dealings for the

District. Ms. Gamble was in the process of obtaining the documentation requested by the Commission when she was hospitalized. Due to a continuing health mater, Ms. Gamble was not able to prepare the information requested before August 15, 2008. The District would request a second extension up to August 22, 2008 in which to accumulate and prepare for filing the additional accounting information requested by the Commission.
