Dear Ms. Stumbo:

In its order of May 22, 2008 in Case No. 2008-00176: "Alleged Failure of the City of Danville to Comply with KRS 278.160 and 278.180 and the Commission's Order of August 10, 1994 in Administrative Case 351", the Commission directed Danville to immediately cease charging any rate to its public utility wholesale customers that differs from its purchased water contract.

Attached is the current bill from Danville to Parksville Water District. The bill appears to be based on the rate Danville has been charging since August 16, 2007. That rate seems to conflict with the Commission's May 22, 2008 order. Parksville understood the order to require Danville to charge the rate that was in effect in June, 2005, prior to the recent improper rate changes by the city.

Also attached is a calculation of the current bill using the rate charged by Danville and the calculated amount using the rate that Parksville believes to be the proper rate according to the May order. There is a difference in each calculation by Danville of its bill that Parksville cannot explain. Because the bill does not include the rate used, Parksville cannot accurately determine what rate was used or how the bill was calculated.

There appears to continue to be a problem with the rate, method and accuracy of the billing by the city, which the Commission should expeditiously investigate pursuant to the May 22^{nd} order.


