Complainant, Jim Devers, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original and 5 copies of the following information, with a copy to all parties of record. The information requested herein is due on or before October 3, 2008. Responses to requests for information shall be appropriately bound, tabbed and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Complainant shall make timely amendment to any prior responses if he obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any requests to which Complainant fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, he shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for his failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request.

1. In the April 15, 2008 letter attached to your complaint, you state that you vacated your former residence at 126 Cherry Hill Drive, Georgetown, Kentucky on January 13, 2007. Were there any appliances left behind after you vacated the premises? If yes, provide information on the type of appliance, the make and model of the appliance, and the age of the appliance.

2. How old was the house located at 126 Cherry Hill Drive at the time you vacated it?

3. Was the water heater operated by electricity or gas? What age was the water heater on January 13, 2007?

4. How old was the heating/air conditioning ("HVAC") system on the date you vacated the subject premises?

5. Was the water heater or the HVAC system inspected at any time after you contacted Kentucky Utilities Company concerning the discrepancy in your July 2007 bill? If an inspection was conducted, provide the results of the inspection.

6. Refer to Complainant's Response to Commission Staff's First Data Request. You stated that the thermostat was set at 77 degrees from April 2007 to the date of the sale of the subject residence. Was there any verification that this setting had not been changed prior to the sale of the residence?

7. To the best of your knowledge, were all electric appliances functioning properly during the period of time in which the subject residence was vacant?

8. Describe any activity inside the subject premises after it was vacated by Complainant.
