On June 10, 2008, Madison County Utilities District ("Madison County") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Madison County purchases water from Richmond Utilities ("Richmond").

2. Richmond notified Madison County that, effective with its July 1, 2008 billing, Richmond's wholesale rate to Madison County would increase from \$2.02 per 100 cubic feet to \$2.08 per 100 cubic feet.

3. During the 12-month period ending April 30, 2008, Madison County purchased 98,657,900 cubic feet of water from Richmond and sold 81,645,740 cubic feet of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$59,194.74, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.07 per 100 cubic feet.

4. Madison County proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.07 per 100 cubic feet for its customers, effective July 1, 2008.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.07 per 100 cubic feet is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Madison County's proposed rates are approved.

2. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.07 per 100 cubic feet as calculated in Appendix A is approved.

3. The rates set forth in Appendix B are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for service that Madison County renders on or after July 1, 2008.

4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Madison County shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets setting forth the rates approved herein.
