ORDER

On June 10, 2008, Fountain Run Water District No. 1 ("Fountain Run") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Fountain Run purchases water from Glasgow Water Company ("Glasgow") and Monroe County Water District ("Monroe").
- 2. Glasgow notified Fountain Run that, effective with its July 1, 2008 billing, Glasgow's wholesale rate to Fountain Run would increase from \$1.40 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.75 per 1,000 gallons.
- 3. Fountain Run incorrectly calculated its increased water cost. The correct calculation of Fountain Run's increased water cost is set forth in Appendix A.
- 4. During the 12-month period ending July 1, 2008, Fountain Run purchased 47,679,500 gallons of water from Glasgow and 7,674,900 from Monroe and sold 44,977,733 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$16,687.83, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates proposed by Fountain Run are denied.
- 2. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.38 per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix A is approved.
- 3. The rates in Appendix B, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for service rendered on or after July 1, 2008.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Fountain Run shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
