If using canned beans, just pour into saucepan, season with salt, sugar and bacon drippings and cook until tender. For frozen put 2 cups of water in saucepan, add salt, bacon drippings and sugar. About 30 minutes before serving put in preheated oven, 325-350 degrees for about 20 minutes or until hot. This may be prepared the day before and refrigerated until ready to heat and serve.

ORANGE GLAZE BEETS

2 1/2 tablespoons of cornstarch

1 can of frozen orange juice 1 can of water

1/2 cup of cider vinegar

1/3 cup of shortening

1/2 cup of granulated sugar 1 egg

1 teaspoon of vanilla

1 1/4 cup of sifted flour 1 1/2 teaspoons of

Spread half in greased 8 x 8 x 2 inch baking pan; spread with pineapple. Top with remaining batter. Combine remaining
