### ORDER

On June 13, 2008, Kirksville Water Association ("Kirksville Water") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Kirksville Water purchases water from Richmond Utilities ("Richmond Utilities").
- 2. On March 31, 2008, Richmond Utilities notified Kirksville Water that, effective April 1, 2008, its Kentucky River Authority ("KRA") withdrawal fee charge to Kirksville Water would increase from \$0.04 per 100 cubic feet of water to \$0.065 per 100 cubic feet.
- 3. Kirksville Water proposes a factor of \$0.04 per 1,000 gallons for its customers, effective June 30, 2008.
- 4. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Kirksville Water's proposed rates are approved.

- 2. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix A is approved.
- 3. The rates set forth in Appendix B are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for service that Kirksville Water renders on or after June 30, 2008.
- 4. The revised tariff sheets submitted by Kirksville Water with the application are approved.
