ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation of regional meetings held during the month of July 2008, in Powderly, Kentucky, Morehead, Kentucky, and Draffenville, Kentucky.

Pursuant to KRS 74.020(7), this Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties." The courses for which approval is sought include instruction regarding, inter alia, water storage tank operation, maintenance, and rehabilitation. Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the proposed course will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her duties and should be approved for 2.0 credit hours for commissioner and board member training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

 KRWA's proposed courses of instruction are hereby approved for a maximum of 2.0 credit hours.
