

MOTION FOR FULL INTERVENTION


Pursuant to KAR 5:001 Section 3(8), Community Action Kentucky, Inc. (CAK), 101 Burch Court, Frankfort, KY 40601, hereby moves for leave to intervene as a full party in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of its Motion, CAK respectfully states as follows:

1. CAK is a Kentucky non-profit, 501(c)(3) public interest corporation that represents the Commonwealth's twenty-three (23) Community Action Agencies.¹ CAK operates the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) in all 120 Kentucky counties and provides assistance to approximately 150,000 low-income households in the state each year. CAK also provides technical assistance on an on-going basis to the state's four Demand-Side Management (DSM) Programs operated by American Electric Power, Louisville Gas and Electric Company, Union Light Heat and Power, and Western Kentucky Gas. These programs provide a variety of conservation services for low income households.
2. By intervening in this action, CAK will present facts and concerns that will not be adequately addressed or represented by any other party. CAK's full intervention

will be helpful to the Commission in fully considering the parties' respective arguments, and will not unduly complicate or disrupt this proceeding.

3. CAK expects to present testimony from Kip Bowmar, Executive Director. CAK may also choose to present testimony from other witnesses not yet identified.
4. CAK therefore respectfully requests that it be granted full intervenor status in this proceeding, including the right to present exhibits and testimony; cross-examine witnesses; submit arguments; and file briefs as allowed by the Commission.
