On August 5, 2008, Black Mountain Utility District ("Black Mountain") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Black Mountain purchases water from the city of Evarts ("Evarts").
- 2. Evarts notified Black Mountain that, effective with its June 2008 billing, the wholesale rate would increase from \$1.75 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons.
- 3. Black Mountain proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.96 per 1,000 gallons.
- 4. During the 12-month period ending July 18, 2008, Black Mountain purchased 28,439,600 gallons of water. It sold 22,227,500 gallons of water during the same period.

- 5. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$21,329.70, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.96 per 1,000 gallons.
- 6. Black Mountain proposes to increase the rates to its customers effective September 13, 2008.
- 7. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.96 per 1,000 gallons is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.
 - 8. Black Mountain misapplied the adjustment factor to the wholesale rate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The rates proposed by Black Mountain are denied.
- 2. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.96 per 1,000 gallons as calculated in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is approved.
- 3. The rates in Appendix B, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and are approved for service provided on or after the date of this Order.
- 4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Black Mountain shall file with the Commission revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
