Banks that would charge this rate amount increase would be considered implementing a "usury" rate, which is illegal. Had an increase been needed, a nominal rate adjustment should have been implemented gradually over years - not one extremely large rate increase. According to Representative Nelson, with this increase, the upgrade expenditures would be recovered in 10 months and then the Water Company would generate \$66,000.00 monthly in increased revenue. An
