## MOTION OF NEXUS COMMUNICATIONS, INC. REQUESTING RETURN OF AN ORIGINAL CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT AND WITHDRAWAL OF ITS PREVIOUS PETITION FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

Nexus Communications, Inc. ("Nexus") respectfully submits this Motion requesting return of an original confidential document and, contingent upon return of that document, requesting withdrawal of its previous Petition for Confidentiality. In support thereof, Nexus submits that on June 16, 2011 it filed responses to the Third Request for Information from Commission Staff (*i.e.*, prior to this matter being held in abeyance) along with a "Petition for Confidentiality" for Confidential Exhibit D attached to those responses.

However, consistent with the *Lifeline Reform Order*<sup>1</sup> issued by the Federal Communications Commission and changes to the facilities-based requirements for eligible telecommunications carriers, Nexus submits that Confidential Exhibit D is no longer relevant to this proceeding. Accordingly, Nexus respectfully requests that this document be returned to Nexus' counsel. Contingent upon return of that document, Nexus respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion Requesting Withdrawal of its Previous Petition for Confidentiality as moot.
