DIALOG TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. PETITION FOR REVIEW OF NXX-X THOUSAND BLOCK CODE DENIAL IN THE PADUCAH RATE CENTER

Dialog Telecommunications Inc. ("Dialog") hereby requests that the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") overturn a recent decision by the North American Number Pooling Administrator ("NANPA") denying Dialog's request for numbering resources for the Paducah rate center. On July 30, 2009 Dialog filed a request with NANPA for one (1) 1000 block of numbers to meet a specific customer request it was unable to satisfy with its existing numbering resources. NANPA denied Dialog's request on the grounds that Dialog has not satisfied the months-to-exhaust ("MTE") and or Utilization requirements established in the Thousands-Block (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guildelines.

Under federal numbering rules, a state commission may overturn NANPA's decision based on the determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for the numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. For the reasons set forth herein, Dialog believes that the Commission is justified in overturning NANPA's decision and should grant Dialog's request for one (1) 1000 block of numbers.

The Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") has found that a carrier

should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due

to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request. Therefore, the

Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision in this matter. In this

present case, Dialog has received a request from Peel & Holland Financial Group for a

contiguous block of 100 direct inward dial ("DID") numbers. Dialog is not able to meet

this request without receiving additional numbering resources. Dialog is attaching copies

of both its request for resources and denial from NANPA.

Dialog believes the request form Peel & Holland Financial Group demonstrates a

verifiable need. Dialog is submitting this petition because of its inability to satisfy a

specific customer request. Therefore, Dialog requests that the Commission overturn the

North American Number Pooling Administrator's and direct NANPA to Grant Dialog's

request for numbering resources.

Section 1.1 Contact information requires that Service Providers supply under "Block Applicant" the company name, company headquarters address, a contact within the company, an address where the contact person may be reached, in addition to the correct phone, fax, and e-mail address. The Pooling Administrator section also requires the Service Provider to fill in the Pooling Administrator's name, address, phone, fax and e-mail.

Section 1.2 Service Providers who need a thousands-block assignment or for an Location Routing Number (LRN) are required to fill in this section. If needed for an LRN, a CO Code Application needs to also be submitted to the PA. The Service Provider should supply the Numbering Plan Area (NPA), the Local Access Transport Area (LATA), which is a three-digit number that can be found in the TelcordiaTM LERGTM Routing Guide. The Operating Company Number (OCN) assigned to the service provider and the OCN its parent company. An OCN is a four-character alphanumeric assigned by TelcordiaTM Routing Administration (TRA). In addition, the number of thousands-blocks requested should be supplied. 
