5. Cross-examination of witnesses will be conducted in the following order:

a. Estate of John Ford;

b. Energy and Environment Cabinet;

c. Attorney General;

d. Joseph Murphy, and

e. Commission Staff.

6. No closing statements shall be permitted.

7. Any party wishing to submit a written brief in this matter shall file such brief

with the Commission within 30 days of the close of the hearing record.

8. The Hearing Officer shall address all motions related to identification and

admission of all exhibits.

9. Counsel for Commission Staff shall retain custody of all exhibits submitted

at hearing. Within 10 days of the close of the hearing record, counsel for Commission

Staff shall prepare a written exhibit list and shall file this list with the Commission, along

with all exhibits and a copy of the video transcript of the hearing.
