O R D E R


This matter arises upon the motion of Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("MISO"), filed February 2, 2010, for full intervention. It appears to the Commission that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering the matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings. The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that MISO should be granted full rights of a party in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The motion of MISO to intervene is granted.
