Dear Todd and Staff,

We would like to add to the record that as of November 8th, 2010 we have begun constructing a home on the property located at 1860 Upper Rock Lick Rd. Hillsboro, KY... Without water or a decision on this matter it is going to be burden trying to construct a home i.e. masonry, concrete and construction in general that requires a water source.

Accordingly, the letter sent by the PSC to Fleming Co. Water dated September 24th, 2010 granted them an extension for the request of information was due October 15th, 2010. The date has come and gone and no information is forthcoming. The record of our teleconference will reflect a statement made by the PSC staff that Fleming Co. Water will provide us with water in accordance with the law. We intend to move on with our life and urge you to add to the record; construction of a home has begun and there has been no decision in this matter.

We also plan to explore the opportunity of including our neighbors who reside below us on the same supply line to consider there options of possibly drinking contaminated water. The one reason Fleming Co. Water is not providing us with water is because there fear of contamination. It defies logic that contamination runs up hill to our farm not downhill to our neighbors and more importantly to a water meter owned by us at 357 Upper Rock Lick Rd., Hillsboro, KY...

We appreciate your efforts however, our attempt to regain county water has been going on for over (3) years.
