
<u>ORDER</u>

On March 17, 2010, Complainant, Billy W. Coke, filed a complaint against Defendant, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU"). Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 12(4)(a), the Commission finds that the March 17, 2010 Complaint does not establish a prima facie case against KU.

Based upon the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complaint filed by Billy W. Coke on March 17, 2010 is DISMISSED without prejudice.
