# MOTION FOR FULL INTERVENTION BY ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY MINISTRIES

Pursuant to K.R.S. 278.310 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(8), ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY MINISTRIES ("ACM"), by counsel, files this Motion for Full Intervention in the above-styled proceeding. ACM's address is P.O. Box 99545, Louisville, Kentucky 40269.

ACM is a Kentucky 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation and its membership is comprised of 15 independent community ministries that provide services in the Louisville Metro area. The common mission for all 15 members is to provide an emergency assistance network in partnership with Louisville Metro Government, local congregations, and other businesses and organizations. Each community ministry serves a specific geographical area to ensure that all of Louisville Metro is covered under the umbrella of the ACM. Among the social services provided by ACM members are utility assistance programs. ACM members provide both financial assistance and advocacy to low-income households that are threatened with disconnection of utility service by Louisville Gas & Electric Co. ("LG&E") because of their inability to pay utility bills. ACM members also implement the Winterhelp program.

ACM has an interest in this proceeding as an assistance provider and advocate for low income utility customers, especially those who because of their inability to afford service are threatened with disconnection. Allowing natural gas retail competition in Kentucky could have a significant, potentially detrimental effect on access by low income utility customers to affordable natural gas service at stable rates; on the terms and conditions under which they may obtain or retain natural gas service; and on the extent to which the Commonwealth and its agencies are able to respond to any harsh effects on low-income customers that may emerge upon implementation.

ACM has participated in several matters before the Public Service Commission including the pending Application of Louisville Gas and Electric Company for an Adjustment of Electric and Gas Base Rates, Case No. 2009-00549; Joint Application of Louisville Gas & Electric Co., Association of Community Ministries, Inc., People Organized and Working for Energy Reform and Kentucky Association for Community Action, Inc. for the Establishment of a Home Energy Assistance Program, Case No. 2007-00337 and Application of Louisville Gas and Electric Company, Inc. for an Adjustment of its Electric and Gas Base Rates, Case No. 2008-00252.

ACM represents an interest that is not otherwise adequately represented, and full intervention by it is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist the Commission in fully considering this matter without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings.
