MOTION OF RETAIL ENERGY SUPPLIERS ASSOCIATION FOR FULL INTERVENTION

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 §3(8) and the Order of the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") entered April 19, 2010, the Retail Energy Supply Association ("RESA") hereby moves for full intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding.

RESA is a non-profit trade association of independent corporations that are among the largest retail suppliers of natural gas and electricity in the United States.¹ RESA's goals and interests as a trade association of retail energy suppliers differ from and are not adequately represented by any other party or prospective party in the above-captioned case. RESA's participation will lead to the presentation of relevant facts and issues that will assist the Commission in the investigation of natural gas retail competition programs. RESA's participation will not unduly complicate, disrupt or delay the proceedings. In support of the foregoing motion, RESA states as follows:

1. RESA's participation in this proceeding will provide the Commission with the important viewpoint of an association that specifically represents the interests of national retail gas and electricity suppliers. RESA has unique experience in working to open and maintain

competitive markets throughout the United States, and can bring real world knowledge and experience from other states' successes and failures.

2. RESA as a trade association of retail energy suppliers has information and experience that is not possessed by any other party.

3. In particular, RESA can bring to the proceeding the experience and expertise of participating RESA members Constellation New Energy, Gas Division, LLC ("CNEG"), Direct Energy, LLC, and Exelon Energy Company.

4. CNEG is a Kentucky limited liability company with its natural gas office located at 9960 Corporate Campus Drive, Suite 2000, Louisville, Kentucky 40223. CNEG is a retail marketer of natural gas throughout the United States, including in Kentucky, where CNEG provides natural gas service to commercial and industrial end users.

5. Direct Energy, LLC is a retail supplier of natural gas and electricity in 20 states and 10 Canadian provinces. Direct Energy serves all sizes of customers from the smallest residential to the largest industrial customers throughout the United States and Canada with over 5 million customer relationships in North America.

6. Exelon Energy is one of the largest retail energy suppliers in the country, and delivers electricity and natural gas products and services to commercial and industrial customers. Exelon Energy has over 11,000 natural gas accounts in Ohio, Illinois, Michigan and Pennsylvania.
