On April 23, 2010, we filed a notice of intent to file an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the construction of a 161 kV transmission line approximately 1.87 miles in length in McCracken County, Kentucky, from KU's Grahamville Substation to the transmission line of EEI near the United States Department of Energy property. Since the application will not be filed within six months of our notice of intent, we intend to let the notice expire pursuant to 807 KAR 5:120, Section 1(1). We currently intend to file the application after October 23, 2011, and will file another notice of intent in a separate document.
