At the outset of the public hearing in the above referenced matter, Andrew Melnykovich, Public Information Officer for the Public Service Commission, welcomed the attendees, introduced the Commission and Commission Staff, and explained the procedure and protocol for the public hearing. Nick Comer, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.'s ("EKPC") Public and Media Relations Representative, then provided a general overview of EKPC's base rate application. Following this presentation, members of the public were provided an opportunity to direct questions to EKPC concerning the company's request for a rate increase. However, there was no member of the public who wished to do so. Dennis Howard, Interim Director of the Attorney General's ("AG") Office of Rate Intervention, made a brief explanation of the AG's position concerning EKPC's rate application.

Chairman David Armstrong then invited the public to make comments to the Commission regarding EKPC's application for a base rate increase. Again, there was no member of the public who wished to do so. The public hearing was then adjourned.
