O R D E R

On January 14, 2011, the Commission authorized Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Nolin”) to pass-through an increase from its wholesale supplier, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc.¹ That Order approved rates which were set forth in the tariff sheets attached as an appendix to the Order. The attached tariff sheets were those filed in this proceeding by Nolin on December 15, 2010.

On February 4, 2011, Nolin filed a motion requesting the Commission to accept tariff sheets included with the motion as a revision to the responses to Items 3 and 4 of the December 15, 2010 filing and to approve new rates for the Acorn Contemporary Type 400 Watt HPS (“400 Watt HPS”) and Santa Rosa Contemporary Type 150 Watt HPS (“150 Watt HPS”) security lights in Nolin’s tariff, Sheet No. 28 for Schedule 5 – Security Lights.

Nolin states that on August 29, 2010, the Commission approved a monthly rate of \$34.17 for the 400 Watt HPS and a monthly rate of \$32.73 for the 150 Watt HPS, and that, due to an oversight, the new security lighting rates were not included in the tariff

sheet information filed with the Commission on December 15, 2010. Consequently, when the Commission issued its January 14, 2011 Order in this proceeding, the tariff sheets attached to that Order did not include the new security lighting rates. However, when Nolin filed its new tariff sheets pursuant to the January 14, 2011 Order, it included the 150 Watt HPS and 400 Watt HPS security lights and listed the rates approved on August 29, 2010.² The rates for the 400 Watt HPS and 150 Watt HPS security lights, as they appear in the revised tariffs included with the motion, reflect a 3.95 percent increase, which is the overall multiplier utilized to determine the increase for security lights.

Based on the motion and a review of Nolin's current tariff and the revised tariffs filed with its motion, the Commission finds that Schedule 5 in the appendix to the January 14, 2011 Order should be corrected as discussed above and as reflected in Nolin's 14th Revised Sheet No. 28, attached as an exhibit to Nolin's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

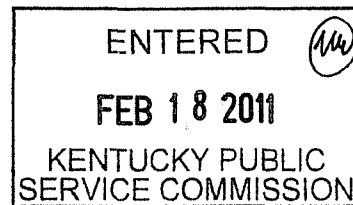
1. Nolin's request to accept the attached tariff sheets included in its motion as a revision to the responses to Items 3 and 4 of the December 15, 2010 filing is granted.
2. The appendix to the January 14, 2011 Order is amended to reflect the monthly per-unit rate of \$35.52 for the Acorn Contemporary Type 400 Watt HPS security light and a monthly rate of \$34.02 for the Santa Rosa Contemporary Type 150 Watt HPS.

3. All other provisions of the January 14, 2011 Order shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Nolin shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates approved herein and stating that they were approved pursuant to this Order.
