**STATUS REPORT OF WOODLAND ACRES UTILITIES, LLC**


Comes Woodland Acres, LLC, by counsel, and for its Status Report filed in the above-styled case, states as follows:

1) An Informal Conference was held in the above-styled case on Wednesday, March 16, 2011, at 2:00 pm at the office of the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to discuss the status of the Letter of Credit and/or Bond to be obtained by Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC. Mr. Murphy, the member of Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC, advised Commission Staff that he has been attempting, without success, to obtain a Letter of Credit or, in the alternative, a Bond to provide security for the operation of the Woodland Acres Wastewater Treatment Plant.

2. The week of March 21, 2011, Mr. Murphy contacted Peoples Bank of Bullitt County, Shepherdsville, Kentucky concerning obtaining a Letter of Credit for Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC. Mr. Murphy was advised that Peoples Bank would provide a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$5,000.00 for Woodland Acres Utilities, LLC. Accordingly, Mr. Murphy is working to obtain the Letter of Credit, which will be in favor of the Commission in the amount of \$5,000.00. As soon as the Letter of Credit is issued, it will be submitted to the Commission, along with the motion

requesting the Commission to accept the subject Letter of Credit in this amount.


