
ORDER

By Order dated February 17, 2011, the Commission granted an adjustment of rates to Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Meade"). In addition to approving a rate increase, the Commission's Order requires Meade to "perform a depreciation study within five years from the date of this order, or the filing of its next rate case, whichever is earlier."

On March 2, 2011, Meade filed a one-sentence request for rehearing which identified as the issue to be reheard the Commission's directive that Meade conduct a depreciation study. However, the request for rehearing does not set forth any explanation or discussion of why Meade should not perform the depreciation study or why a rehearing should be granted. Therefore, the Commission finds that Meade should file a supplemental request for rehearing, which sets forth the reasons why Meade should be relieved of the obligation to perform a depreciation study and why rehearing should be granted. Meade's supplemental request for rehearing should be filed no later than March 14, 2011 to be considered timely under the provisions of KRS 278.400.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Meade shall file, no later than March 14, 2011, a supplemental request for rehearing as discussed in the findings above.
