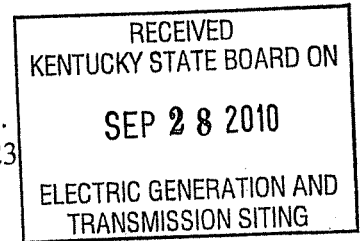

Summary of Testimony:

Mr. Sights will testify regarding the direct and adverse effects that Vectren's proposed transmission line will have on the property owned and maintained by the City. Mr. Sights is expected to testify concerning how the costs incurred by HWU would be borne by the rate payers of the City and Henderson County. Mr. Sights will testify about

the residential and environmental impacts of Vectren's line that will adversely affect the City's property as well as the conflict presented by Vectren's proposed route with the City of Henderson's Water Utility property on Drury Lane and the significant impact on the intended use of this property. He will provide testimony relating to the alternative route proposed by the City, including residential and environmental impacts and the impact on the City's fire station. Further, Mr. Sights will testify concerning the significant adverse impacts upon legal, scenic, historic, aesthetic and perhaps archaeological assets and property of the City and Commonwealth of Kentucky. Mr. Sights will also testify that the City has not given and will not give consent to Vectren to construct its transmission line on, over, or across City-owned property as proposed and that Vectren does not have authority to condemn the City's public property.


