Informal Conference

An informal conference was held in this matter on Friday, August 27, 2010. Representatives of Duke Energy and Commission Staff were present for this meeting. An attendance list is attached.

The purpose of the conference was to discuss the incident involved in this case.

Rocco D'Ascenzo, counsel for Duke Energy, started the conference by discussing the way in which Duke designs its distribution system and when the particular line in question was put into place. He and Russell Atkins, Duke's distribution design manager, discussed the difference in the current NESC and the NESC that was in place when the line was constructed. They spoke of the investigation on the day of the accident, the measurements that were taken, and the grade of the area.

Commission Staff asked questions, and discussions took place concerning the grade of the land, when the particular line had last been inspected, and the difference in the elevation depending on the outside temperature. Commission Staff also asked questions concerning when the transmission under construction was installed and whether any changes to the original structures had been made since they were put into place. There was also discussion on Duke's construction standards.

A discussion was held regarding the line in question and what category of Table 232-1 of the NESC was the appropriate category for it to be placed under, Category 4 or 5. Commission Staff's position is that Category 4 is the appropriate category.

Settlement negotiations were also discussed and the meeting was adjourned.
