MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING INDEFINITELY

Comes now Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (“Meade County”), by and through counsel, and respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) for an Order indefinitely continuing the hearing currently scheduled for December 2, 2010. In support of this Motion, Meade County states as follows:

1. On November 9, 2010, representatives of Meade County attended an informal conference with Commission Staff. At the informal conference, Meade County and Staff discussed the terms of a Settlement Agreement which would dispose of all issues in this case.
2. Meade County believes that the Settlement Agreement discussed at the November 9, 2010, informal conference will eliminate the need for the December 2, 2010 hearing.
3. Meade County believes that Commission Staff does not object to this Motion and that a draft Settlement Agreement will be prepared by Staff in the next few weeks which will dispose of all outstanding issues in this case.

WHEREFORE, Meade County respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order indefinitely continuing the December 2, 2010 hearing in this matter.
