

Informal Conference Memorandum

An informal conference ("IC") was held in this matter on Wednesday, Nov. 3, 2010. The participants were as follows:

The purpose of the IC was to discuss the development of a procedural schedule, potential formal hearing dates and costs currently owed by Cricket Communications, Inc. to Brandenburg Telephone Company for the facilitation of wireless traffic.

During the course of the IC, the parties and Commission Staff discussed the following issues:

- PSC Staff noted that as of today, Cricket had not filed an Answer to the Arbitration.
  
- Cricket stated it was deliberately waiting to file an Answer until after the IC was held due to some recent developments in the case. Cricket stated that the parties have a plan to extend the negotiation window and the

parties believe the petition will be resolved very soon. Cricket stated that the parties are close to completing a final ICA.

- Brandenburg stated that it expects to file a notice of dismissal of the petition by November 10<sup>th</sup> and then will file a final ICA shortly thereafter.

The informal conference then adjourned.
