
Dear Mr. Derouen,

I am exercising my right to intervene in the above mentioned matter. The 81% rate increase proposed by Hillridge Facilities, Inc. is an outrage and should be quickly denied by the PSC.

HFI already charges exorbitant rates, neglects the maintenance and upkeep of the system and provides virtually non-existent customer service. The only thing nastier than the stench that emanates from their aging facility is the attitude you get from Mrs. Ridge should you be unfortunate enough to ever have to deal with her. The Ridge's are apparently motivated by simple greed. NOTICE

Hillridge Facilities, Inc. has filed an application with the Public Service Commission proposing to increase its monthly sewer rate from \$24.13 to \$32.50, an increase of 34.7%. Hillridge believes it could justify a rate increase of 55.6% based upon its operating costs, but has requested the much lower increase to reduce the burden upon its customers. Hillridge is also proposing to begin charging a surcharge of \$11.19 per month for 36 months to pay for sewer line repairs and replacements mandated by the Kentucky Division of Water. The proposed effective date of the change is November 29, 2010.

Upon request from an intervenor, the utility shall furnish to the intervenor a copy of the application and supporting documents.
