MOTION TO DEVIATE FROM RULE GOVERNING THE FILING OF COPIES


Comes Hillridge Facilities, Inc. (“Hillridge”), by counsel, and pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 14, hereby moves the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to authorize it to deviate from its rule requiring Hillridge to file an original and ten complete copies of its Supplement to Responses to Commission Staff’s Second Information Requests for the following reasons:

- 1) Staff Request for Information number 2 requested Hillridge to provide a copy of the most recent infiltration and inflow study performed on Hillridge Facilities’ system. Hillridge obtained a copy of this infiltration and inflow study from the Louisville and Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District (“MSD”) pursuant to KRS 61.870, et seq. MSD responded to this infiltration and inflow study by providing DVDs reflecting the inspection of the Hillridge collection system, along with 287 pages of supporting information. Due to the expense of reproducing the DVDs and copiers of the 287 pages, Hillridge requests leave to file one copy of the DVDs and one hard copy of the supporting documents. Hillridge would also forward an electronic copy of the 287 page document to counsel for the Public Service Commission.
- 2) Staff Request for Information number 13(b) requested Hillridge to provide a copy of all letters of warning and notices of violation that DOW has issued to Hillridge

Facilities regarding its infiltration and inflow problems. Copies of these records will be filed with Hillridge's Supplement to Responses to Commission Staff's Second Information Requests.

- 3) The granting of Hillridge's motion would ensure that the Commission is provided with a copy of the DVDs reflecting MSD's inspection of the Hillridge collection system, as well as the documentation supporting the infiltration and inflow study, without exorbitant cost to Hillridge.


