This Application of the Todd County Water District ("Applicant") respectfully shows:

- 1. That Applicant is a water district created and existing under and by virtue of Chapter 74 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
 - 2. That the post office address of Applicant is:

- 3. That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks construction project, consisting of extensions, additions, and improvements (the "Project") to the existing waterworks system of Applicant; (ii) an Order approving increased rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.
- 4. The project consists of the construction and installation of a 500,000 gallon elevated water storage tank and appurtenances.
- 5. That Applicant proposes to finance the construction of the Project through (i) the issuance of \$994,000 of its Waterworks Revenue Bonds, and (ii) a USDA, Rural Development ("RD") grant in the amount of \$426,000. Applicant has a commitment from RD to purchase said \$994,000 of bonds maturing over a 40-year period, at an interest rate of not exceeding 3.25% per annum, as set out in the RD Letter of Conditions filed herewith as an Exhibit.
