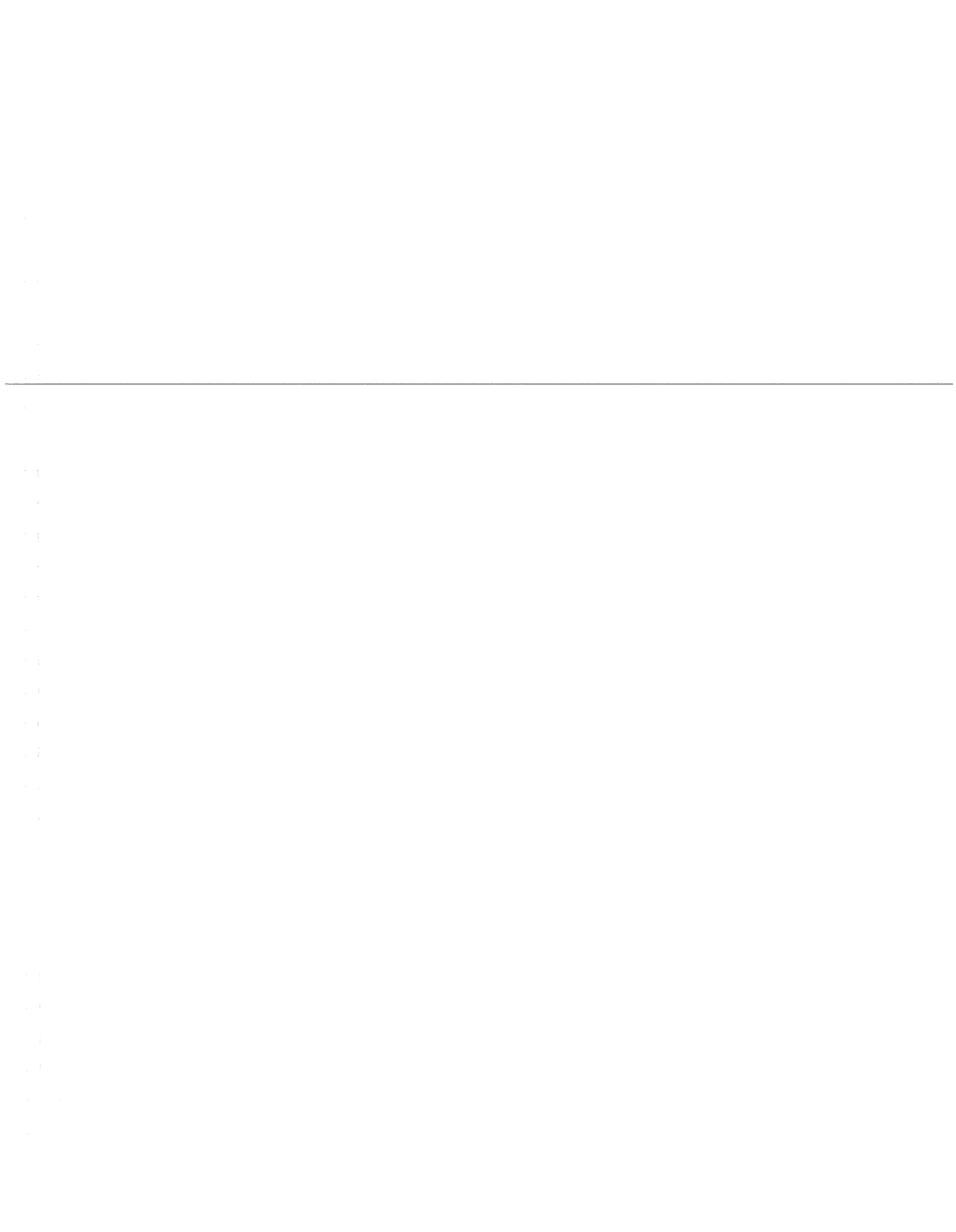

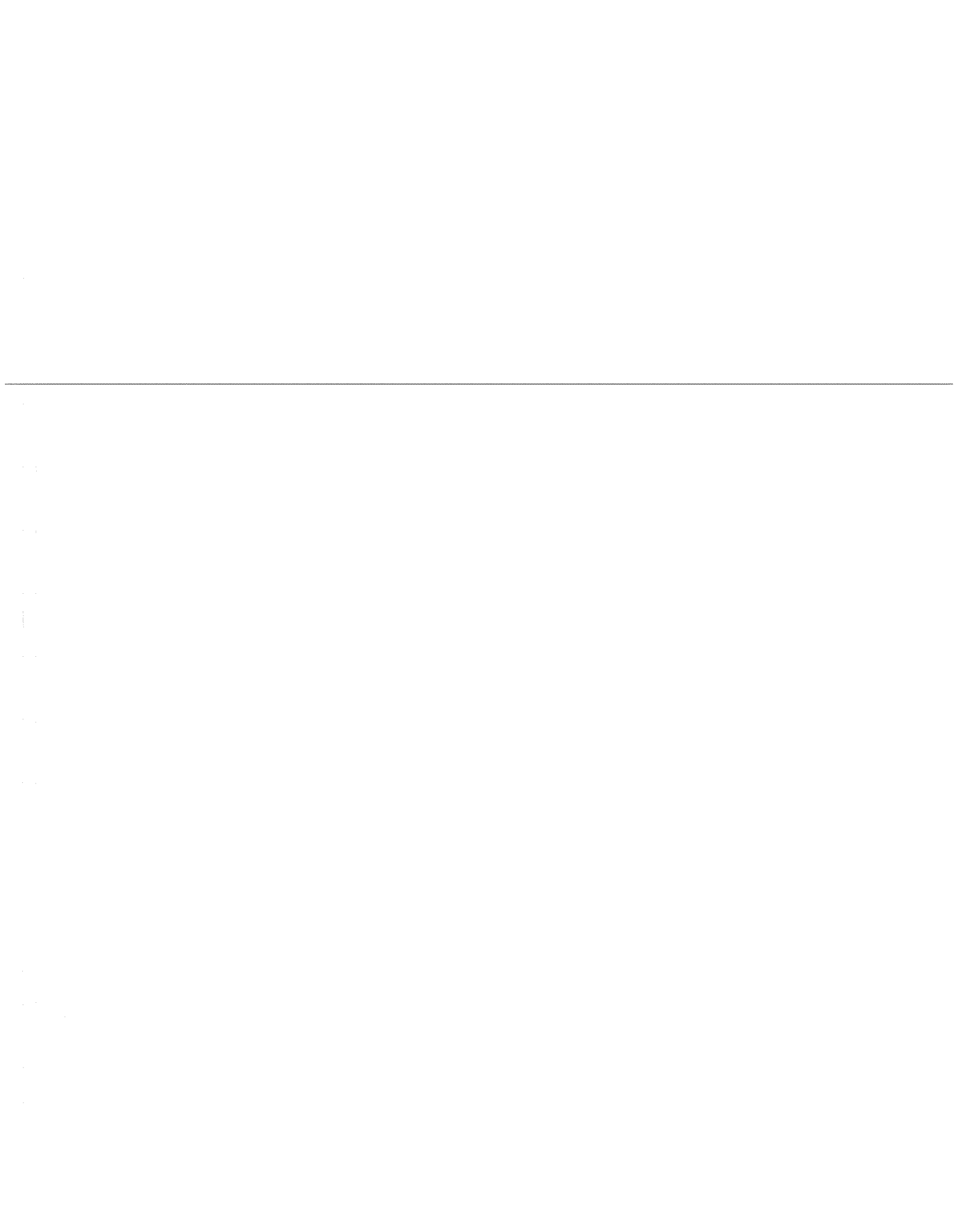

Item 1

Refer to the electronic copies of Exhibit JDG-5 and the Loss Factor Schedule. Exhibit JDG-5 uses a line loss factor of 6.0038 percent. Provide the location of this factor in the Loss Factor Schedule.

Response

It is not on the Loss Factor Schedule. The 6.0038% is the loss amount reflected in the current Renewable Energy Resource Tariff mark-up. It is one minus the quotient of a) the present wholesale mark-up of \$0.0346 per kWh divided by b) the retail mark-up of \$0.03681 per kWh. $0.060038 = (1 - 0.939962)$



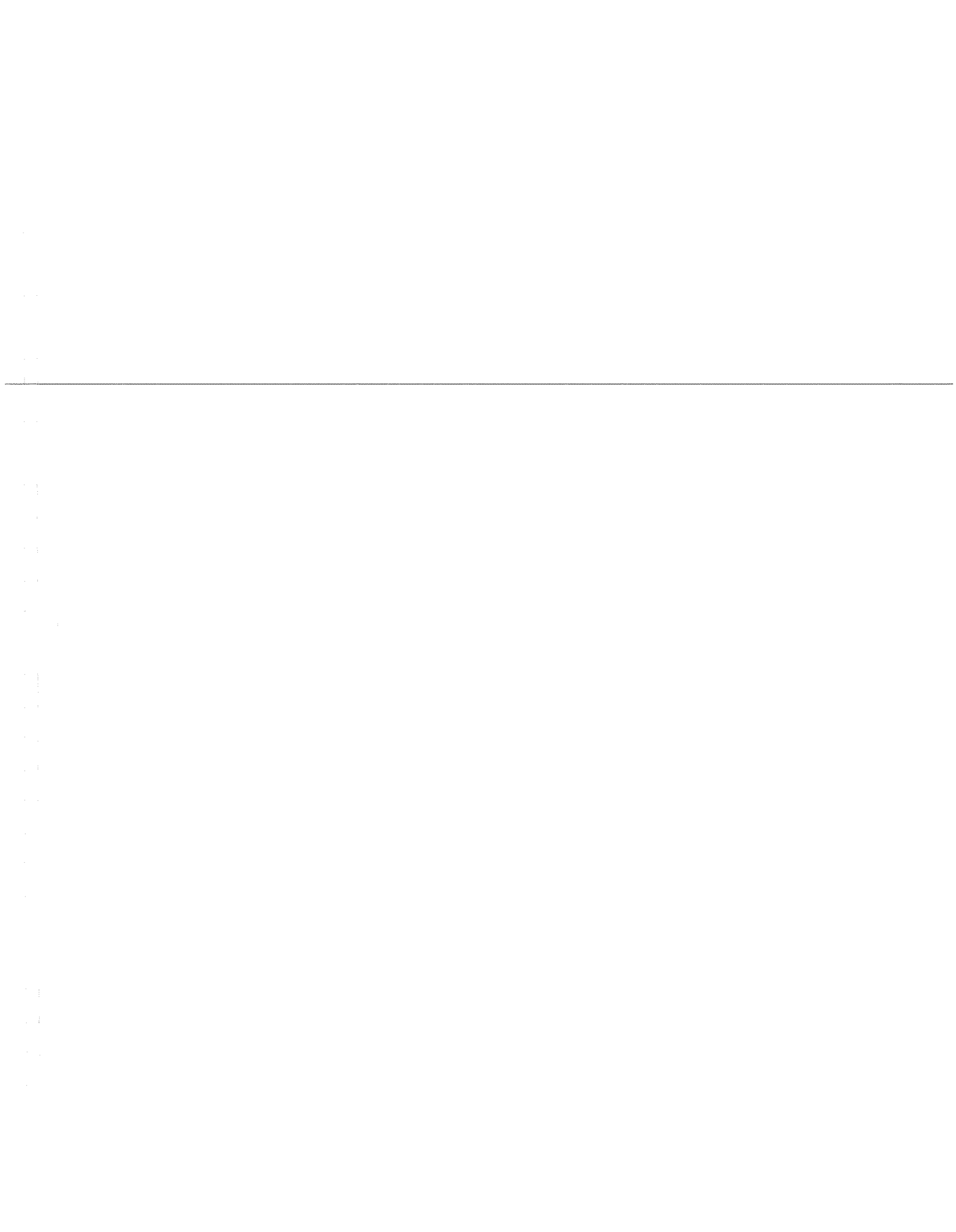

Refer to page 1 of 2. Meade Uses the abbreviation "F(b)" in the Non-Fuel Adjustment Clause Purchased Power Adjustment (Non-FAC PPS") formula. Given that this abbreviation is used in the formula in Schedule 18 of Meade's tariff, the Fuel Adjustment Clause, state whether Meade intended to use the abbreviation "PPA(b) in the Non-FAC PPS formula instead of "F(b)".

Response

Yes, PPA(b) should be used in place of F(b)

Item 3 b.

Refer to page 2 of 2. The first sentence in the second paragraph provides a list of the rates to which Section 1 of the Non-FAC PP rider would apply. Meade's Rate Schedule 4, Large Power Service (1,000 KVA and Larger Time-of-Day) is not included in the list. State whether Schedule 4 is omitted because there are no customers on that schedule. If no, explain why Schedule 4 is omitted. If yes, explain why this rider should not apply to any future customers served under Schedule 4.

This non-FAC Purchased Power Adjustment Clause ("PPA") is a rider to all rate schedules of Meade County RECC ("Meade" or "Corporation").		
NON-FAC PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT RATE		
<u>SECTION 1</u>		
<u>BILLINGS TO CUSTOMERS SERVED FROM NON-DEDICATED DELIVERY POINTS</u>		
Billings computed pursuant to rate schedules to which this section is applicable shall be adjusted based on the following formula where all references to costs and revenues will exclude amounts associated with customers served from Dedicated Delivery Points.		
The non-FAC purchased power adjustment rate applicable to kWh sold in the current month under each rate to which this section applies shall be based upon the following formula:		
$PPA = \frac{W_PPA - O + U}{P(m) \times L} - PPA(b)$		
Where;		
PPA = the non-FAC purchased power adjustment rate per kWh for the current month		
W_PPA = the non-FAC PPA amount charged by the Corporation's wholesale power supplier on power bill for the second month preceding the month in which PPA is applied.		
P(m) = the kWh purchased in the second month preceding the month in which F is applied.		
L = One minus the percent system energy losses equal to the rolling twelve month average not to exceed ten percent (10%).		
O = any over recovery amount from the second preceding month.		
U = any under recovery amount from the second preceding month.		
PPA(b) = Base non-FAC purchased power adjustment factor of \$.00000 per kWh.

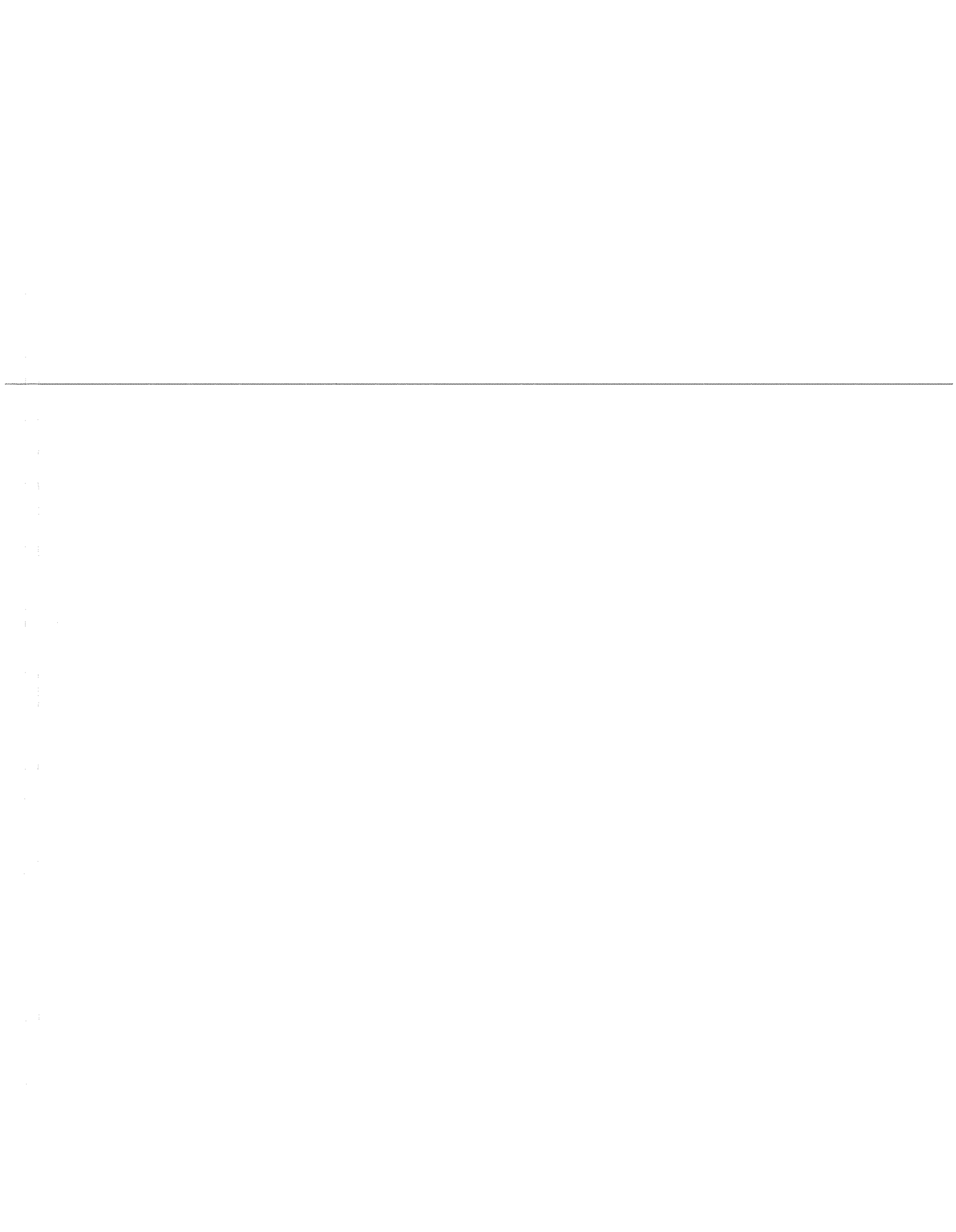

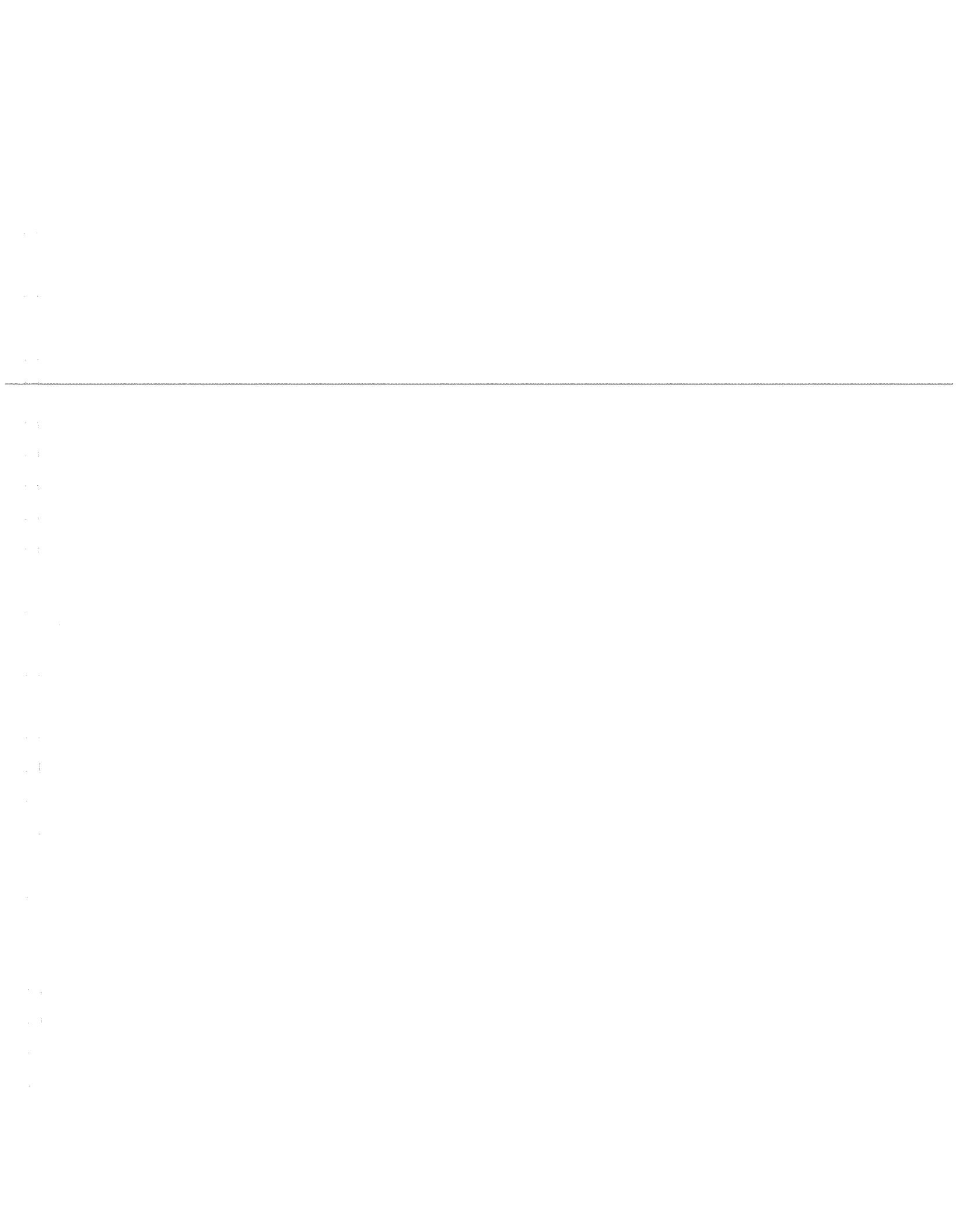
