The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Protection you filed on May 16, 2011 on behalf of Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential pursuant to Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.878. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as being contained in supporting documents to KU's Responses to information requested in the Commission's Data Request dated May 5, 2011, Items 1 and 2. The information is more particularly described as copies of the Complainant's electric utility bills containing the Complainant's account number.

Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the public disclosure of the information would present an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy to the Complainant.

Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, the Commission has determined that the information requested to be held confidential is of a personal nature, which if publicly disclosed would present an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy to the Complainant. Therefore, the redacted information requested to be treated as confidential **meets the criteria for confidential protection** and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.
