

JOINT APPLICANTS' MOTION TO RESCHEDULE HEARING

Come now the Joint Applicants, by and through counsel, and move the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission"), for an Order rescheduling the hearing of this case from July 6, 2011 to July 8, 2011 and July 11, 2011. In support of this Motion, the Joint Applicants state as follows:

By previous Order of the Commission the hearing in this case is scheduled for July 6, 2011. However, because of irreconcilable scheduling conflicts, witnesses for both Duke Energy and Progress Energy are unavailable on that date. However, all of the Progress Energy witnesses and three of the Duke Energy witnesses (Rogers, DeMay, and Wiles) are available to provide testimony on July 8, 2011. The other three Duke witnesses (Janson, Wathen and Stanley) are available to provide testimony on July 11, 2011.


The Joint Applicants regret that this scheduling issue has arisen. However, the affected witnesses are located in Charlotte and Raleigh, North Carolina, and Cincinnati, Ohio and have previously made other scheduling commitments which would be virtually impossible to reschedule.

This Motion is not made for purposes of hindrance or delay but, rather, to attempt to accommodate the schedules of very busy executives, the Attorney General, and the Commission so that adequate time can be set aside to receive very important direct testimony and provide an opportunity for cross-examination on that testimony and on responses to Data Requests for which these witnesses have responsibility. The Joint Applicants have previously discussed these dates with both the Attorney General and Commission Staff at the Informal Conference held on May 19, 2011.

WHEREFORE, the Joint Applicants respectfully request that the Commission enter an Order rescheduling the current hearing date from July 6, 2011 to July 8 and July 11, 2011.


