<u>ORDER</u>

On February 5, 2010, the Commission granted the request of Tennessee Telephone Service, LLC d/b/a Freedom Communications USA, LLC ("Tennessee Telephone") for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC").¹ Tennessee Telephone was authorized to receive low-income support and not high-cost support. On April 11, 2011, Tennessee Telephone petitioned the Commission for withdrawal of its ETC status.

47 USC § 214 (e)(4) states in part:

eligible The state commission shall permit an telecommunications carrier to relinguish its designation as such a carrier in any area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier. An eligible telecommunications seeks relinguish carrier that to its eliaible telecommunications carrier designation for an area served by more than one eligible telecommunications carrier shall give advance notice to the State commission of such relinguishment. Prior to permitting a telecommunications carrier designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier to cease providing universal service in an area served by

more than one eligible telecommunications carrier, the State commission shall require the remaining eligible telecommunications carrier or carriers to ensure that all customers served by the relinquishing carrier will continue to be served, and shall require sufficient notice to permit the purchase or construction of adequate facilities by any remaining eligible telecommunications carrier. The state commission shall establish a time, not to exceed one year after the State commission approves such relinquishment under this paragraph, within which such purchase or construction shall be completed.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to USC 47 214(e)(4) above, there is more

than one ETC in the area of relinquishment and those carriers have sufficient facilities

for the provision of service.

The Commission being sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

Tennessee Telephone's request to withdraw as an ETC is granted. This case is now

closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
