

**JOINT MOTION BY DREW FOLEY, JANET OVERMAN, GREGG WAGNER, RICK
CLEWETT, RAYMOND BARRY, SIERRA CLUB, AND NATURAL RESOURCES
DEFENSE COUNCIL TO DEVIATE FROM RULE**

Rick Clewett, Raymond Barry, Drew Foley, Janet Overman, Gregg Wagner, Sierra Club, and Natural Resources Defense Council's (collectively "Environmental Intervenors") move the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 § 14, to deviate from the requirement that parties file with the Commission an original and fifteen (15) complete copies of all responses and attachments with regard to the Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively, the "Companies") November 7, 2011 Response to Environmental Intervenors' Motion to File Corrected testimony. In the Companies' Response they requested that Environmental Intervenors provide the Strategist input and output files supporting the testimony immediately. Environmental Intervenors request permission to

produce the Strategist input and output files and work papers on a USB storage device.

Environmental Intervenors are serving the USB storage device on the Companies today but seek permission to file service copies of the USB storage device responses to all parties tomorrow at the hearing.

In support of this joint motion, Environmental Intervenors state as follows:

1. Environmental Intervenors are filing a large number of data files and other documents in response to the Companies' request in the Response to Environmental Intervenors' Motion to File Corrected Testimony, totaling thousands of pages.
2. Many of these data files, in paper form, are of little, if any, practical use to the Commission or the Companies.

WHEREFORE, Environmental Intervenors respectfully request permission to deviate from the rules and the Commission's June 28, 2011 Order to provide an original and fifteen (15) paper copies of responses and instead allow Environmental Intervenors to submit the responses and attachments, including service copies, on a USB storage device.
